### **Level 100 – Genesis to Revelation** **Room #225**

#### **Teacher: Jeff Hambek**

Have you ever felt lost in the details of scripture? Why not take a step back from the details to see the whole picture? Take a refreshing journey through the Bible in the fun, fast paced, fact filled class "Genesis to Revelation".

### **Level 200 – Overview of the Book of Isaiah** **Fellowship Hall**
